

Dear Applicants,

The sub-committee has made great progress with the process of bringing applicants on board. The goal is to be very inclusive and with this in mind there might be some category changes for applicants to ensure the best outcome for each individual.

It should also be noted that all applicants may be required to perform or write an assessment of some sort. The assessment will be determined by the sub-committee, and the aim thereof is to ensure that minimum standards are met across the profession.

Please note that the process of determining the categories is not finalised at this point, as legal opinion is still being considered.

The process will continue with the following suggested time line in mind.

- Current
  - Committee is assessing received curriculums against the minimum standards
  - Start the process of assessing applicatons
- November
  - Committee meeting with further evaluation of applicants
  - Communication will be sent out to each applicant with the suggested category changes, “bringing on board” (registration/authorisation) pathway and if any additional information is required to process their specific application.
  - Applicants will have an allocated time in which to reply.
  - Once we receive the replies, the applications and suggested “bringing on board” pathways will be sent to full council for approval.
- June 2019
  - Our aim is to have the process finalised by June 2019. Special examinations and other suggested assessment criteria will only be planned for after this date.
