

THE HEALTH OF YOUR ANIMALS IS IMPORTANT. ONLY A SAVC REGISTERED VETERINARIAN MAY DIAGNOSE, TREAT & PERFORM PROCEDURES ON YOUR ANIMALS

- Only veterinarians whose training is assessed by the South African Veterinary Council (SAVC) may register with the SAVC and may diagnose, treat and perform procedures on your animals
- Veterinary training in South Africa is amongst the best in the world. Veterinarians who qualified abroad must pass the SAVC's registration examination to register and render veterinary services in South Africa
- Veterinarians have to keep up to date with the latest scientific knowledge and have to submit annual proof to the SAVC on how they keep up to date



- Veterinary practices comply with minimum standards set by the SAVC and are subject to inspection by the SAVC
- Veterinarians are involved in many spheres of animal and human health and are engaged with research in advancing evidence-based knowledge
- Veterinarians play an increasingly important role in developing new methods of diagnosing and treating animal diseases
- Veterinarians control animal diseases for the benefit of animals and humans.
